## Welcome

If you have never boarded your pet you may have questions or concerns. You may have anxiety about how we treat your animal. You may imagine your pet is stressed out. Let us reassure you that we here at Richland Animal Hospital Boarding take every measure to make your pet comfortable, happy and most of all safe. The following will help you and your pet to have a successful boarding visit.

## Owners: What to expect

We at Richland Animal Hospital will provide a safe, happy and well taken care of pet during your visit. We are licensed and insured. Our staff ensures that your pets are fed twice daily and watered every time they are let out; which, at our facility, is four times daily. We offer additional services at an additional cost. Before your pet returns home you may want a bath, nail trim or additional one on one play care. Just ask one of our boarding members when you check-in.

## What to bring

Please bring your pet's food from home to avoid any stomach sensitivity or possible diarrhea resulting from food change. We use Hill's Sensitive Stomach food in case you forgot yours, but it is best to have your pets normal diet.

We will administer your pet's vitamins, supplements or prescription medication. Provide detailed instructions for administering.

You may bring bedding and a toy, or a chewie but this is not necessary. Bedding is provided. We have stainless steel bowls for your pet's needs, so please leave yours at home. This ensures that yours do not get lost or misplaced.
